

Health and Safety Policy

NZRS National Limited (NZRS) is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy working environment for its employees, visitors, contractors and others, whose well-being and safety could be affected by Property Services work activities or business activities.

The NZRS National Limited Directors hold overall accountability and responsibility for ensuring that we:

- Identify all existing and new hazards and take all reasonably practicable steps to implement effective controls to either eliminate or minimise any risk of harm or injury.
- Ensure that all workers are made aware of hazards in their workplace and are trained, provided with information and where appropriate, supervised to undertake their duties safely.
- Ensure all personal protective equipment needed to secure health and safety standards is provided to employees and that they are adequately trained in the proper use, storage and maintenance of this equipment.
- Encourage and support employees and applicable unions to be actively involved in consultation and participate in the health and safety management process.
- Proactively encourage the timely and accurate reporting of, and investigation of all near miss, incidents and injuries.
- Encourage the early reporting of pain or discomfort and actively support safe early return to work for injured or ill employees.
- Promote a system of continuous improvement in its health and safety performance which includes regular review of policies and procedures.
- Meet our obligations under the Health and Safety at Work Act (2015), plus relevant legislation, standards, codes of practice or guidelines.

In addition, every person working for Property Services is required to:

- Carry out their work in a way that does not adversely affect their own health and safety, or that of others.
- Attend required training and observe all safe work procedures, rules and instructions that will allow them to work safely.
- Promptly report incidents (including near misses and injuries) to the appropriate person.
- Actively participate as required in any reviews or investigations, to improve health and safety practices.
